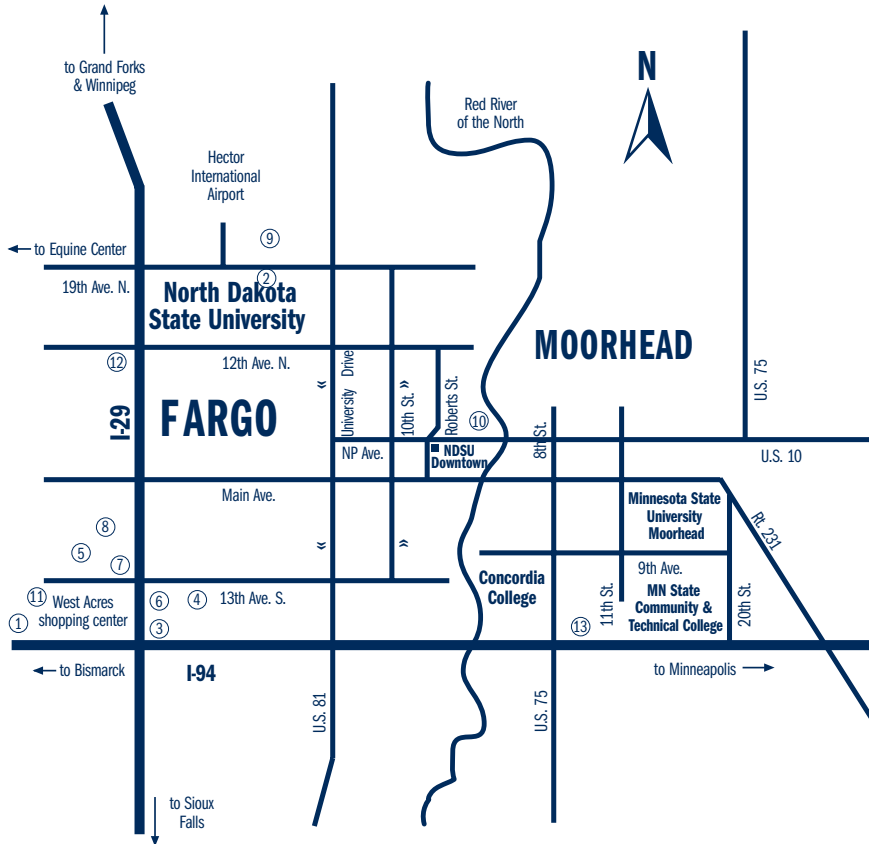
CAMPUS PARKING
